

Canine Adult Semi-Annual Wellness Visits

The American Animal Hospital Association, through which we are accredited, recommends twice-yearly examinations for pets. Pets age faster than their human counterparts. Our veterinarians help you keep your pet healthy throughout their lifetime by these biannual visits. By examining them more than once a year, they are more likely to “catch” issues that may go unnoticed. Thorough examinations are one of the most important things veterinarians do for your pet. In them, they look from nose to tail, looking for any issues your pet may have. Catching and treating most issues early can either help to cure them completely or manage them successfully, making your pet healthier and more comfortable throughout his or her life. A blood chemistry and CBC (Complete Blood Count) assist your veterinarian in diagnosing and treating any conditions found before they can become clinical.

**Heartworm, flea and tick products are dispensed based upon the weight of the pet and are therefore, not included in the total cost. Animal Hospital of Statesville recommends ALL pets remain on heartworm, internal and external parasite prevention year-round for the safety of your pets and your family.
