We're excited to announce that we now have a <u>Laparoscope!</u> Dr. Brett Pendergrass will be using this amazing tool as an option for less invasive ovariectomies - an alternative to traditional ovariohysterectomies. This surgery removes only the ovaries through 2 small incisions. Recovery time is half the time of a regular ovariohysterectomy, where the uterus is also removed. Stay tuned for more information on this wonderful new option!
