Therefore, the more often the veterinarians see them, the better their chances of catching issues before they become a major problem. At Animal Hospital of Statesville, we rotate our canine vaccines after the first adult annual. Therefore, vaccines administered will vary, depending on your dog's vaccination history. We have included prices for vaccines that are not considered core, but, depending on a dog's environment, may be recommended vaccines for your dog.
